Style Sheet

The paper should contain the following:

- (1) Title
- (2) Name of the author
- (3) Affiliation of the author (in English) , i.e. University of South Bohemia
- (4) Address of the author (country in English) – i.e. Slovak Republic
- (5) E-mail of the author
- (6) Abstract
- (7) Body of the text
- (8) References

Format

Length: **up to 6 pages**

File: ***doc, *rtf**

Paper size: **A4**

Font: **Times New Roman** (11 pt – text; 9 pt - footnotes)

Line spacing: **single spaced**

1st line: **left-hand margin 1,25 cm**

Please **do not insert page numbers**

Title: **bold, centered**

Author's name: **centered**

Affiliation: **centered**

Abstract: **bold, aligned left**

Headings: **bold, aligned left, separated from the text by a blank line**

Citations: please use intext citations, with the author's surname, the year of publication and a reference to page(s); e.g. (Lacan 1988: 88)

Footnotes: footnotes should be marked consecutively throughout the text by a raised number directly following a punctuation mark.

Figures, tables: figures, tables etc. should be provided on a separate page (with appropriate reference in the text) or inserted as moveable objects in the text.

References: the reference section (under the heading **Works Cited:** bold, aligned left, followed with a colon and separated from the list of works by a blank line) should contain all works referred to in the text. They are listed in alphabetical order of author/editor, with complete bibliographical details. For books with more than three authors, the first name and the abbreviation et al. should be used. Book and journal titles are in italics. Titles of articles in books and journals are in regular font style. Page references are required for articles in books and journals.
