## **Nomination Process**

In order to do this, please send the following materials in an email to <u>International@GeorgiaSouthern.edu</u>. More detailed information can be found on our <u>exchange student page</u>. The application deadline is April 1, 2019.

- Completed Georgia Southern Exchange Student Application for Admission
- Completed <u>I-20/DS-2019 Data Form</u>
- Copy of official home university transcript
- <u>Course Request List</u>
- Copy of TOEFL or IELTS scores
- Original financial documentation showing personal funds (\$5,550 to cover health insurance and personal expenses for the year)
- <u>Certificate of Immunization</u>
- Copy of passport information page

## **Orientation and Housing**

After the students have been admitted to Georgia Southern University, they will receive information about registering for SOAR (orientation) and applying for a residence hall. This information will likely come from International Admissions; students can see their options <u>here</u>.

## **Program of Study**
